

# Nail Gun Safety

- Over 42,000 injuries last year
- A gun like this can have a muzzle velocity of 1500 ft/sec. Compare to a .45 ACP pistol at 830 ft/sec



- Always wear safety glasses.
- Always disconnect the air tools when moving even a short distance.
- Never carry tool with finger on trigger.
- Don't point tool toward anyone.
- Don't leave tool unattended when tool is connected to air supply.
- Do use proper regulated air supply.
- Make sure you buy / rent a "sequential trigger nail gun"
  - The alternative sequential-trip trigger, requires the nose contact to be depressed before the manual trigger, rather than simultaneously with the trigger, to discharge a nail, making unintentional discharge of nails less likely.
