~ **SmartPlant[®] Instrumentation External Editor Download** ~



The SmartPlant Instrumentation External Editor allows the an external party, such as a vendor, EPC or contractor, to open specification sheets that have been created in SmartPlant Instrumentation and modify them as needed. The modified specification sheets can then be imported back into SPI for further processing.

Note that you cannot open .isf files generated by SPI 2009 or updated by External Editor 2009 with External Editor 2007 or earlier versions. If you open and modify a .isf file generated by SPI 2007 or updated by External Editor 2007 in External Editor 2009, you will not be able to import that file into SPI 2007 or External Editor 2007. Please make sure you are using the appropriate version of External Editor matching your target SPI version.
